Tuesday, November 21 at 10:00 a.m. (Parents Arrive)

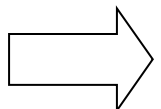
Tuesday, November 21 at 1:30 p.m. (Parents Arrive)

Try this at home!!! Here is a fun and easy game to play with your child to encourage counting. All you need is a one die, candy corn, and placemats (1 per player). Everyone takes a turn counting the total number of candy on their placemat and the person who has the most is the winner.
