Try this at home!!! Here is a fun and easy game to play with your child to encourage counting. All you need is a one die, candy corn, and placemats (1 per player). Continue with each player rolling the die and counting out that number of candy until all of the candy corn is gone and the game is over. Everyone takes a turn counting the total number of candy on their placemat and the person who has the most is the winner. (This game can be played year round by changing the candy and the placemats.)
